2. Heard Sri Imtiaz Husain and Sri Pawan Kumar Shukla, learned counsels for the petitioner and perused the records.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced before the Court an order dated 07.02.2025 passed in Writ-C No. 37927 of 2024 (Mohd. Rizwan Vs. Election Commission of India), a perusal of which goes to show that the said writ petition was dismissed as having become infructuous by a Division Bench of this Court.

7. Notice issued to the respondents shall indicate 05.08.2025 as the date, by which the respondents shall file their defence by way of written statement together with the list of documents, whether in their possession or not, upon which they intend to rely as evidence in support of their defence.
8. The notice shall further state that in case of default of appearance on or before the date fixed, the matter shall be heard in their absence.
9. List the matter on 05.08.2025.
